WAR SOLDIER, WOUNDED AT THE BATTLE OF STILLMANTON... and now, in checking the Haverhill, N.H. Cemetery, we have to have found no gravestone for JAMES GOLD, JR. WHO WAS WOUNDED AT HIS FATHER'S and in the Revolutionary War Service until his discharge in Sept. 1777... (unless you know where it is and can contact me?) If we can locate the site, then a suitable stone can be erected to his memory.

I do hope Mrs. Day (Hannah B. Gold Day) may have had in her keeping some of the family records... so you can help us with this?

Sorry to have to write to you as complete strangers... but if you are relatives of Mrs. Day... you may not be strangers at all?
